ECTA Responsible Care: 10 Years of (some) documentation tools



- **KPI Reporting** (*sometimes stressful to get sent in*). Basic principles stayed the same, some amendments over the years.
- **Annual Improvement Plans**, a stable tool for our RC members for internal and external use.
- **RC Level I and II templates** in SQAS modules (the 2019 revision now being finalized).

ECTA Responsible Care: 10 Years with some results



- Developments visible in the RC KPIs
- Better fleet composition data, showing improved emissions.
- Better coordinated improvement plans with more structure developing over the past 10 years.

ECTA Responsible Care: But 10 Years of changes in our world
