SQAS recognized as an alternative system to the OCS certification scheme



- ➤ 16 November 2022: The OCS Supervisory accepted SQAS as an alternative assessment system to the OCS certification scheme to show compliance with OCS mandatory requirements
- > 1st March 2023: Start of SQAS assessments with the new system

How SQAS assessed companies will show compliance with OCS requirements



- 1. If during a SQAS assessment, 100 % of the OCS mandatory requirements are accomplished, an attestation/report showing this compliance will be issued to the assessed company. Cefic will communicate the name of the company to PE/EuPC for inclusion in the OCS Public Register.
- 2. The OCS Public Register will show OCS certified companies (plastics producers and plastics converters) and SQAS assessed companies fulfilling 100% of OCS mandatory requirements
- 3. If the assessment mentioned in 1 shows that the company is not fulfilling 100% the OCS mandatory requirements, the company will have to carry out intermediate(s) assessment(s) till this status is reached




