SQAS recognized as an alternative system to the OCS certification scheme

- **16 November 2022:** The OCS Supervisory accepted SQAS as an alternative assessment system to the OCS certification scheme to show compliance with OCS mandatory requirements
- **1st March 2023:** Start of SQAS assessments with the new system

How SQAS assessed companies will show compliance with OCS requirements

1. If during a SQAS assessment, 100 % of the OCS mandatory requirements are accomplished, an attestation/report showing this compliance will be issued to the assessed company. Cefic will communicate the name of the company to PE/EuPC for inclusion in the OCS Public Register.
2. The OCS Public Register will show OCS certified companies (plastics producers and plastics converters) and SQAS assessed companies fulfilling 100% of OCS mandatory requirements
3. If the assessment mentioned in 1 shows that the company is not fulfilling 100% the OCS mandatory requirements, the company will have to carry out intermediate(s) assessment(s) till this status is reached

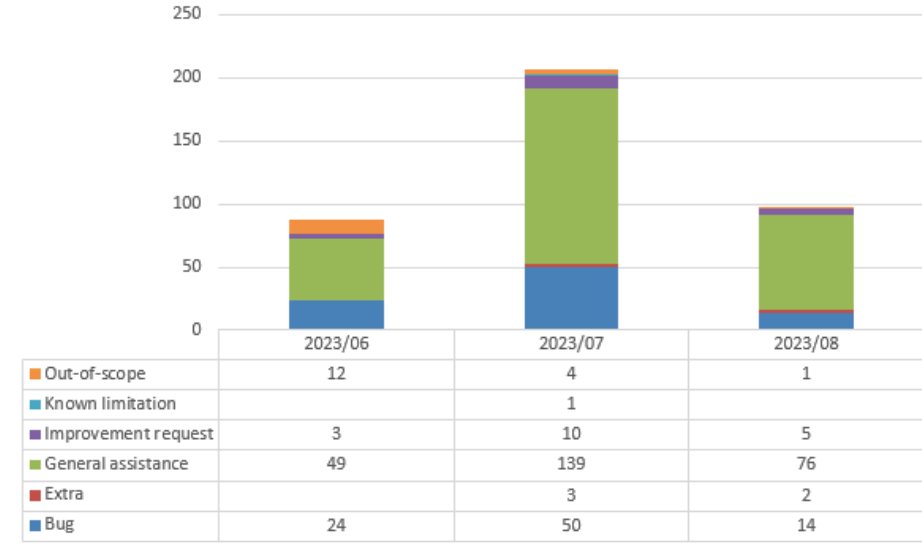

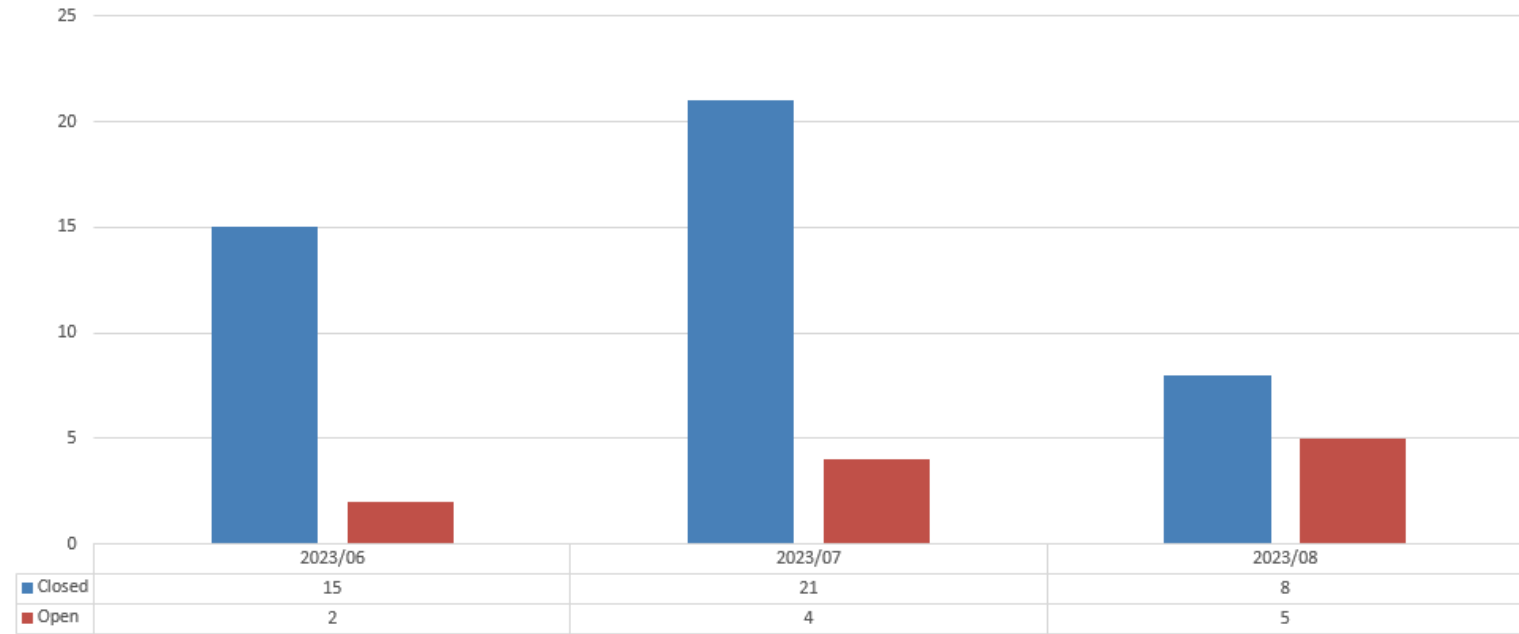

ESAD ASSESSMENT FEEDBACK

- Some remark system wise given for the assessment calculation of days/hours, especially for Site & Chlorinated Solvents questionnaires);
- 696 questions to answer in 20 hours (1200 minutes), 2 minutes for each question.
- Verified with different Assessors and it depends also on the working methodology of the Assessor herself/himself.
