



SQAS 2025

Questionnaires published, launch 15 september 2025

- Questions merged/deleted or modified:
 - 31 questions from Core
 - 47 questions from TS
 - 62 questions from WH
 - 58 questions from TC







in 2022) Update in 2026 (tbc)





New Key Requirements



- GHG Emissions: Compliance with ISO 17083, GLEC V3.1 and future EU Regulation.
 Also extra focus on accuracy and subcontractors
- Compliance with IMO Circular MEPC/909 for plastic pellets (warehouses, distributors, forwarders, transport companies).
 New EU regulation on plastic pellet losses might influence as from 2026-2028
- New Module: Container Depot /Transfer Terminal (replacing existing sections)
- Digitalisation: additional checks on cybersecurity (NIS2 risk management)
- New risk to be assessed: cryogenic conditions (hazards: burns, asphyxiation, explosion, fire).

GHG Emission measuring

Key principles

- Understand & define transport categories
 - Energy usage
 - Related transport chain activiteis (cleaning, storage, depot,...)
- Measure and assign activity
- Measure and assign energy consumption (truck => order => category)

Tips

- Read GLEC v3.1 and Cefic/ECTA guideline
- Accuracy before detail, but relevant detail (>L2)
- Own assets first
- Intensity is the differentiator, be better than default
- Participate in digitalisation
- Expect the same from subcontractors

IT security: no rocket science questions, but very relevant in daily operations!

- Cyberattacks, infectious malware
- Mobile device security
- Multi-factor authentication (MFA) to access IT systems
- Software updates, back up and recovery plan
- Audit of IT systems in the last 12 months, penetration testing

Data availability & sharing

- Basic operations data (location, ETA, equipment,...)
- Structured sharing with customers (eECD, ePPL,...)

- Leads to accreditation for conducting SQAS audits in designated territories.
- ISO lead auditor certification no longer required, but relevant audit experience. DGSA certificate remains essential.
