In 2009, the “European Chemical Transport Association” (ECTA) launched its Responsible Care Initiative. Today, this initiative enjoys recognition and appreciation in the chemical industry. LKW WALTER has supported the initiative from the start and was one of the first companies to join it.

With the official publication of the position papers on 20th October 2025, the industry is sending a strong signal for cooperation and innovation. Together with ECTA, LKW WALTER is driving forward digitalisation in Combined Transport and is actively shaping the future of networked logistics.
